The cost is \$4.00 per manifest and must be paid by check, cashier's check, or money order made payable to Treasurer, State of Illinois.

**Phone orders are not accepted. The correct fee must accompany each manifest order. Failure to complete this form accurately and completely will result in rejection of the manifest request, and possible forfeiture of the manifest fee.**
