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PREFACE

Forty-five landfills reported more than one billion gate cubic yards of remaining capacity as of January 1, 2012, up less than one percent from a year ago. This leaves the state with 23 years of landfill life remaining.

It should be noted that this figure included capacity from five inactive facilities in Fairview, Greenville, Harrisburg, Jerseyville and Streator. The figure for remaining capacity also included capacity from two landfill expansions permitted during 2011 at Veolia Environmental Services (ES) Zion, Zion and Rochelle Municipal Landfill No. 2, Rochelle.

During calendar year 2011, the application for an expansion at Veolia ES Zion landfill in Zion was approved. Rochelle's landfill expansion proposal was approved on July 18, 2011.

In 2011, 40 active landfills in Illinois accepted almost 46.2 million gate cubic yards of municipal waste for disposal. No new landfills opened in 2011 and no landfills closed during 2011. Landfills completing certification of closure in 2011 included ERC/Coles County Landfill/Charleston on July 27, 2011.

Inspections of waste management facilities are conducted by personnel from Illinois EPA's seven regional field offices and our delegated partners. Our delegated partners include 17 counties, Ambraw Valley Solid Waste Agency and the City of Chicago. They have our Agency's authority delegated to them to inspect landfills, transfer stations and compost sites in their jurisdictions and to investigate citizen complaints about illegal dumping of waste.

Introduction

Nonhazardous Solid Waste Management And Landfill Capacity 2011

Nonhazardous Solid Waste Management and Landfill Capacity in Illinois: 25th Annual Report (2011)

Section 4 of the Illinois Solid Waste Management Act requires the Agency to "publish a report regarding the projected disposal capacity available for solid waste in sanitary landfills. . . . Such reports shall present the data on an appropriate regional basis. . . [and] shall include an assessment of the life expectancy of each site."

This legislative mandate explains why the main body of this report is organized by seven Illinois EPA administrative regions and why landfill capacity and life expectancy are emphasized in text and landfill specification pages in the regional sections.

Statewide Data Overview

In calendar year 2011, 40 Illinois landfills accepted almost 46.2 million gate cubic yards of solid waste, one-tenth of one percent (0.1%) more waste than was accepted during 2010. Some of these landfills were not active during the full year; and none of the active landfills closed during the year. Several landfills submitted their affidavit of certification of closure, and some were approved.

Landfill operators report that 13.3 percent of that waste amount was accepted from 11 other states. All landfills are required to report amounts of out-of-state waste accepted. Twenty-two (22) of the 40 landfills (55 percent) accepted more than 6.1 million gate cubic yards of waste from other states.

Landfill capacity increased by less than one percent year to year

Capacity remaining reported by 45 landfill owners and operators as of Jan. 1, 2012, increased by less than one percent (0.3 percent). This total of more than one billion gate cubic yards of available capacity was up almost 2.8 million gate cubic yards from data reported a year earlier.

Landfill life in years means remaining capacity divided by waste disposed. This figure tells how long a region may be served by local landfills at current disposal rates, barring capacity adjustments, until capacity is depleted. The figure as of Jan. 1, 2012 is 23 years of landfill life remaining. The regions range from a low of 12 years of landfill life remaining in Region Two: Chicago Metropolitan to a high of 54 years in Regions Three: Peoria/Quad Cities and Seven: Southern Illinois.

Banned wastes to include electronics after Jan. 1, 2012

Trucks arriving at a landfill are inspected for prohibited nonhazardous wastes and for hazardous wastes that Illinois bans from disposal in landfills, including: bulk liquids, landscape wastes, lead

acid batteries, potentially infectious medical waste, used motor oil, white good components and whole tires.

Beginning January 1, 2012, computers, monitors, televisions and printers will be banned from landfill disposal. Under the new law passed in August 2011, the list of items required to be recycled is expanded to include keyboards, portable music devices, scanners, videocassette recorders, video game consoles and more will also be banned from disposal in landfills.

Loads are weighed and details about them are recorded. They are then taken to the exposed portion of the active cell, which is known as the working face.

Inactive landfills may be allowed to "temporarily close"

Streator Area Landfill #3, Streator, had a permit application that was withdrawn from Agency review on Mar. 5, 2010 for a horizontal expansion. The operation has been temporarily closed since 2005. On Apr. 28, 2006, RCS Landfill Inc., Jerseyville, also became inactive, for business reasons and continues inactivity, but reports capacity. Saline County Landfill, Harrisburg, also ceased accepting waste on June 7, 2006. The operator declared to Illinois EPA that it was "temporarily closed," and still is during the current year. Spoon Ridge Landfill, Fairview, has been temporarily closed since 2008, although it has been reporting the most available capacity for the past 14 years. On additional landfill: Bond County Landfill, Greenville reported it ceased accepting waste on March 31, 2010, and yet continues to report available capacity.

The total number of Illinois landfill operators that reported available capacity to Illinois EPA, as of Jan. 1, 2012, was 45. This total includes the four temporarily closed landfills named above as well as the landfill in Greenville that became inactive for business reasons on March 31, 2010.

Permanent landfill closings affect local capacity

No landfills closed during 2011. However, two landfills reached their capacity limit and closed their gates during 2010. In Region Four, Clinton Landfill #2, Clinton, ceased accepting waste on June, 15, 2010. This site closed after the Clinton Landfill #3 opened across the street. In Region 6, Bond County Landfill, Greenville, closed on March 30, 2010. Salem Landfill, Salem, one of the State's few city-owned and operated landfills, closed on October 15, 2010.

All of these landfills in the state were open into 2012, including the newer facilities of Atkinson Landfill, Atkinson and Clinton Landfill #3, Clinton, which opened in 2009. No new facilities opened in either 2010 or 2011.

Several landfills submitted affidavits of certification of closure to Illinois EPA in 2011, and some of them have received approval.

Capacity is up almost 2.8 million gate cubic yards, as documented on Jan. 1, 2012

In a year that brought a less than one percent increase in landfill capacity, three regions reported capacity increases ranging from 1.5 to 6.6 percent. There was almost a 2.8 million gate cubic yard increase from year to year. However, four regions reported a decline of available capacity. Region Four's capacity declined the most at 5.6 percent. Regions Five, Six and Seven also reported declines in capacity ranging from 1.7 to 3.8 percent.

Capacity is increasing because of landfill expansion proposals, rather than new landfills

During calendar year 2011, the application for an expansion at Veolia ES Zion landfill in Zion was approved on June 3, 2011. Rochelle's landfill expansion proposal was approved on July 18, 2011.

During 2010, Laraway Recycling and Disposal Facility (RDF), Elwood/Joliet received the approval to expand its landfill from the Agency's Bureau of Land.

How to Check Status of Bureau of Land Permit Applications on the Internet

Permit application forms are found on-line at http://www.epa.state.il.us/land/forms.

Once the Agency receives a permit application, the Bureau of Land, Permit Section (Section), proceeds with the review. One of the databases available to everyone on the Internet is the Solid Waste Unit's web database search. With this database, one can determine the status of permit applications that have been submitted.

A Solid Waste Unit web database search at http://www.epa.state.il.us/land/databases is designed to inform the public about applications submitted, or permits obtained from the Bureau of Land (BOL). The Section issues permits for the management of non-hazardous waste at landfills, transfer stations, compost and waste storage, treatment, processing and recovery facilities.

On the search results page, the log number is linked to a brief description of the application. The main identifiers for applications are:

- 1. Any part of the BOL name of the site
- 2. The closest city to the site or
- 3. The county where the facility is located

Choose search method from "Active" or "Inactive" applications:

"Active" means an application is pending for the site. "Inactive" means that there are no applications currently pending, but there may be applications for which the Section has taken final action (issued, denied or withdrawn).

Public versus Private Ownership and Operation of Landfills in Illinois

Knox County located in the Peoria/Quad Cities area (Region Three) is the last public entity to both own and operate their landfill.

There are also counties that own and/or operate landfills. Whiteside County owns the Prairie Hill RDF in Morrison, in Northwestern Illinois (Region One). Will County owns Prairie View RDF in Joliet in the Chicago Metropolitan Area (Region Two) and Knox County located in the Peoria/Quad Cities area (Region Three) is the last public entity to both own and operate their own landfill; also the County of Peoria jointly owns the Peoria City/County Landfill No. 2 landfill with the City of Peoria, but leaves the operation to a private entity.

Some cities in Illinois own landfills in the state, but do not operate them. For example, in Region 1, Northwestern Illinois, the City of Rochelle owns the landfill located there; and in Region 3, Peoria/Quad Cities, the City of Peoria and the County of Peoria jointly own the Peoria City/County Landfill No. 2 through their Solid Waste Board.

The rest of the landfills in the state are both privately owned and operated.

Conclusion

The seven administrative regions are:

Region One: Northwestern Illinois; Region Two: Chicago Metropolitan; Region Three: Peoria/Quad Cities; Region Four: East Central Illinois; Region Five: West Central Illinois;

Region Six: St. Louis Metropolitan East and

Region Seven: Southern Illinois.

Region One covers the following 12 counties:

The counties of Boone, Bureau, Carroll, DeKalb, JoDaviess, LaSalle, Lee, Ogle, Putnam, Stephenson, Whiteside and Winnebago are located in Region One: Northwestern Illinois.

Landfills

All seven landfills in Northwestern Illinois Region remained open throughout 2011. Four landfills in Region One were in the top ten rankings of all the state's landfills in terms of waste receipts in 2011. Winnebago Landfill, Rockford ranked first in the state by accepting almost 5.7 million gate cubic yards. Veolia ES Orchard Hills Landfill Inc., Davis Junction was second accepting almost 5.1 million gate cubic yards; Prairie Hill RDF, Morrison was seventh, receiving more than 2.1 million gate cubic yards; and Lee County Landfill Inc., Dixon, was tenth with more than 1.5 million gate cubic yards of municipal solid waste accepted for disposal.

Region One's seven active facilities received more than 15 million gate cubic yards of municipal waste in 2011. The waste receipts for 2011 showed that more than 1.2 million less gate cubic yards waste was received than the year before. The waste receipts declined year to year by 7.3 percent. Even so, these landfill operators managed 33.3 percent of the waste accepted for disposal in the State of Illinois, more than any other region.

Out-of-state waste accepted from Iowa and Wisconsin

Prairie Hill RDF reported accepting waste from the State of Iowa. Veolia ES Orchard Hills Landfill Inc. accepted waste from Iowa and Wisconsin. All together this total of 265,805 gate cubic yards amounted to 1.7 percent of the total waste accepted in the Region's landfills.

Capacity increase of 6.6 percent reported as of Jan. 1, 2012

Capacity available for waste disposal in the region increased by 6.6 percent from 2011 to 2012, by a total of more than 15.0 million gate cubic yards. The reported remaining available capacity in the region was almost 244 million gate cubic yards. This region was one of three in the state reporting increasing capacity. Also reporting increasing capacity were Region Three: Peoria/Quad Cities and Region Two: Chicago Metropolitan.

Sixteen years of capacity remain for region as of Jan. 1, 2012: three landfills rank in top ten listing of largest landfills

This region is second in the state behind Region Three: Peoria/Quad Cities, in remaining capacity, with a 23.3 percent capacity share. Veolia ES Orchard Hills Landfill reported almost 91.2 million gate cubic yards of space available as of Jan. 1, 2012, making it third in the state in capacity rankings on that date. Lee County Landfill Inc. reported the fifth largest capacity, at

more than 58.2 million gate cubic yards. Prairie Hill RDF reported more than 42.1 million gate cubic yards of capacity available and ranks eighth.

The Region's seven active landfills may provide 16 more years of waste disposal capacity for the region, compared to 23 years of landfill life for the entire state.

Illinois EPA Permit Approval for Expansion of Existing Landfills: 2010-2011

The permit application (Log No. 2009-445) that was submitted by the owners and operators of Rochelle Municipal Landfill, Rochelle, for a horizontal expansion was approved on July 17, 2011. The design airspace is 9.2 million cubic yards.

The Winnebago Landfill, Rockford, has submitted a permit application (Log No. 2010-133) for a lateral expansion to the West consisting of 8.0 million cubic yards. Agency action was pending as of Dec. 31, 2011.

Region Two covers the following nine counties:

The counties of Cook, DuPage, Grundy, Kane, Kankakee, Kendall, Lake, McHenry and Will are located in the boundaries of Region Two: Chicago Metropolitan. Cook County includes the solid waste management planning groups of City of Chicago, South Suburban Mayors and Managers Association (SSMMA); Solid Waste Agency of Northern Cook County (SWANCC); West Cook County Solid Waste Agency (WCCSWA) and Cook Co. (rest of the county).

Landfills

Twelve years of capacity remain for Region Two based upon current waste disposal rates. This is the least number of years of remaining landfill life of all the regions. The other regions ranged between 16 and 54 years, for a statewide average of 23 years.

On Jan. 1, 2012, capacity at the Chicago Metropolitan Region's landfills was almost 93.7 million gate cubic yards, an increase of 1.5 percent from the previous year. The capacity as reported by landfill operators was up by almost 1.4 million gate cubic yards.

Prairie View Recycling and Disposal Facility (RDF), Wilmington, has 52.2 percent of the capacity available locally. It is ranked sixth in the state, in terms of available capacity.

One active landfill is located in Cook County: County Seat, City of Chicago

River Bend Prairie Landfill, Dolton, is the single active landfill located in Cook County. It is ranked 18th in terms of waste acceptance in the state; and 41st in terms of available capacity.

Waste accepted increased by 20.4 percent in 2011

The volume of solid waste buried in 2011 in Region Two increased by 20.4 percent from the previous year. The region's landfills received almost 7.9 million gate cubic yards of waste, which amounted to 17.1 percent of all waste disposed in landfills in Illinois that year. That amount was over 1.3 million gate cubic yards more than the previous year.

Top 10 ranking for Prairie View RDF: The most active landfill in the region

Prairie View Recycling and Disposal Facility accepted more than 2.7 million gate cubic yards of waste for disposal in 2011. This landfill ranked sixth of the 40 landfills reporting during 2011. However, in the case of this landfill, waste is only accepted for disposal from municipalities located in whole or in part within Will County's borders.

Veolia ES Zion Landfill, Zion reported accepting more than 1.6 million gate cubic yards of waste for disposal in 2011. This landfill ranked ninth of the 40 landfills reporting during 2011.

Out of state waste receipts: from three States: Indiana, South Dakota and Wisconsin accepted at four landfills in the region

A total of 13 percent, equating to 1,030,279 gate cubic yards, was accepted from three states, Indiana, South Dakota and Wisconsin.

Laraway RDF, Elwood/Joliet accepted 961,816 gate cubic yards from Indiana, which was 94 percent of its waste receipts. River Bend Prairie Landfill received 3 percent of its waste receipts from Indiana. Veolia ES Zion Landfill accepted 3 percent of its waste from Wisconsin. Environtech Inc., Morris, received less than 1 percent of its waste from Indiana and South Dakota

Veolia ES Zion Landfill's vertical expansion approved in June 2011

Veolia ES Zion Landfill's proposal to expand the landfill vertically by 1.7 million cubic yards was approved by the Illinois EPA on June 3, 2011. This capacity was then included in the owner/operator reported amount on Jan. 1, 2012.

Horizontal expansion at Laraway RDF approved in 2010

A horizontal expansion of 18.2 million gate cubic yards was proposed at Laraway RDF located in Will County. In May 2010 the permit application was withdrawn by the operator. This application became integrated into the RCRA Part B Permit B-141-R that was approved by Illinois EPA on June 21, 2010.

Closure of landfills means less waste accepted in region

This region has faced several closures in recent years, as its landfills fill to capacity. For example the CID RDF (Area No. 4) in Calumet City/Chicago certified its site as closed Dec. 15, 2009. Congress Development Company, Hillside closed on Jan. 31, 2008, and has a certificate of closure under Agency review.

The counties of Fulton, Hancock, Henderson, Henry, Knox, Marshall, McDonough, Mercer, Peoria, Rock Island, Stark, Tazewell, Warren and Woodford are located in Region Three: Peoria/Quad Cities.

Landfills

Nine landfills in the Peoria/Quad Cities area reported more than 263.1 million gate cubic yards of capacity remaining at the beginning of 2012. Total capacity was 4.3 million gate cubic yards more than the amount that was reported the previous year. Total capacity in the region increased 1.7 percent from the previous year.

These landfills in Region Three accounted for 25.1 percent of the more than one billion gate cubic yards of disposal capacity remaining statewide on Jan. 1, 2012.

Fifty-four years of landfill life remaining

The longest amount of landfill life is 54 years in both the Peoria/Quad Cities region and the Southern Illinois Region. Chicago Metropolitan Region had the least, with 12 years.

Waste disposal amounts increased by 5.7 percent

The Region's eight landfills active in 2011 reported accepting more than 4.8 million gate cubic yards of waste for disposal. However, in Region Three, 260,257 more gate cubic yards of waste was received than during 2010, up 5.7 percent.

Twenty-one percent of waste receipts came from seven other states

Of the almost 46.2 million gate cubic yards of solid waste disposed in Illinois' landfills in 2011, 13.3 percent was imported from 11 other states. For Region Three, 21.3 percent of its waste receipts originated from seven of these 12 states. More than 1.0 million gate cubic yards of out-of-state waste was disposed at three of the Peoria/Quad Cities area landfills.

Sixty-three (63) percent of the out-of-state waste accepted at Quad Cities Landfill, Phase IV, was from Iowa and Wisconsin. Eighteen (18) percent of the waste accepted at Upper Rock Island County Landfill came from Iowa. Envirofil of Illinois, Macomb accepted less than 1 percent of its waste from Iowa. Peoria Disposal Company (PDC) #1, Peoria also accepted waste from Iowa, and Wisconsin, as well as Indiana, Kentucky, Minnesota, Missouri and Nebraska.

All landfills remain open into 2012

All active landfills in the region expect to remain open into 2012. However, the PDC #1 Landfill, Peoria is close to closure, and plans to cease accepting waste sometime during 2013. PDC #1 is the only landfill in Illinois currently permitted to accept hazardous waste.

Knox County Landfill #3, Oneida remains as the only county-owned facility that is also operated by the county. Other county-owned facilities include Whiteside County-owned Prairie Hill RDF, Morrison and Will County-owned Prairie View Landfill, Wilmington.

Jointly owned by the City of Peoria and the County of Peoria is Peoria City/County No. 2, Brimfield. In Northwestern Illinois, Rochelle Municipal Landfill No. 2 is also owned by the City of Rochelle.

All other landfills are privately owned and operated.

Spoon Ridge Landfill has ranked first in capacity for 14 years

The state's largest landfill, Spoon Ridge Landfill, Fairview, has 50.6 percent of the landfill capacity in the region, translating to 12.7 percent of the State's capacity. The facility has been the state's largest landfill since Jan. 1, 1998, but has been inactive from June 2008 through 2011.

An affidavit for certification of completion of closure (Log No. 2011-250) has been submitted to the Illinois EPA for review. Once approved the permitted capacity will be zero. The status is still under review as of Dec. 31, 2011.

Quad Cities Landfill, Phase IV proposes to expand, still pending approval or denial

Permit Log No. 2008-376 requests approval from the Agency for a vertical and horizontal 15 million cubic yard expansion at Quad Cities Landfill, Phase IV, Milan. This review was still pending approval or denial as of Dec. 31, 2011.

Region Four covers the following 19 counties:

The counties of Champaign, Clark, Coles, Crawford, Cumberland, DeWitt, Douglas, Edgar, Effingham, Ford, Iroquois, Jasper, Livingston, Macon, McLean, Moultrie, Piatt, Shelby and Vermilion are located in Region Four: East Central Illinois.

Landfills

Almost 7.1 million gate cubic yards of waste was accepted in seven East Central Illinois landfills during 2011. This figure has declined more than 406,000 gate cubic yards from the previous year, a difference of 5.4 percent.

Livingston Landfill, Pontiac, took in 54.8 percent of the Region's waste receipts, and was third in the state's rankings in terms of waste receipts. Livingston Landfill accepted more than 3.8 million gate cubic yards of waste for disposal, all of it from Illinois counties. This landfill was the only one in the region to appear in the top 10 listing for active landfills.

Waste was also received from four other states at three landfills

Three of the Region's landfills accepted a total of 55,380 cubic yards of waste from four states besides Illinois. Waste imported into the East Central Illinois region came from Indiana, Iowa, Missouri and Wisconsin. Waste haulers from Indiana sent waste to landfills in Danville and Hoopeston. Indiana's waste amounted to 6 and 5 percent respectively of the waste received at these two landfills owned by the same company, presumably because of their proximity to the Illinois-Indiana border.

Clinton Landfill #3, Clinton, a landfill that opened in 2009, also accepted waste from Indiana and Iowa, as well as Wisconsin. Out-of-state waste amounted to less than 1 percent of Clinton Landfill #3's total waste receipts in 2011.

On Jan. 8, 2010, modification number 9 to its permit was approved to allow the reconfiguration of Clinton Landfill #3 into two units: 22.5 acres will be the Chemical Waste Unit in the southwestern corner and the rest would be considered the municipal solid waste unit.

Clinton Landfill #2 closed in June 2010

Clinton Landfill #2, across the street ceased accepting waste on June 15, 2010. It stayed open for almost one year after Clinton Landfill #3 was permitted to open. Since the landfill did not accept any waste during 2011 or report any capacity as of Jan. 1, 2012, it was not included in this report. An affidavit for certification of completion of closure is pending Illinois EPA review and approval as of Jan. 12, 2012.

Available capacity down 5.6 percent

Available capacity reported at eight landfills in the region on Jan. 1, 2012 totaled more than 179.6 million gate cubic yards. The region was third highest in terms of capacity remaining of all the regions (capacity share of 17.2), with the exception of Region Three: Peoria/Quad Cities which reported 25.1 capacity share and Northwestern Illinois, Region Four: (capacity share of 23.3).

Streator Area Landfill #3, Streator, again reported capacity at the year's beginning, though it has been inactive since 2005

A total of more than 10.6 million less gate cubic yards of landfill capacity was available in East Central Illinois at the beginning of 2012. This figure amounted to a 5.6 percent decline in capacity year to year.

Still, 25 years of landfill capacity remain for the East Central Illinois Region. This comes in behind two regions tied for first: Region Three: Peoria/Quad Cities and Region Seven: Southern Illinois both ranked at 54 years of landfill life remaining.

Two landfills rank in the top 10 list for available capacity

Together, 13.5 percent of the landfill capacity available in the state is found at Livingston Landfill, which also ranked second in the state's capacity rankings and at recently opened Clinton Landfill #3 which ranks seventh.

Illinois EPA is currently reviewing a landfill expansion proposal in Decatur

A permit application has been submitted for Illinois EPA review for a proposed lateral and vertical expansion amounting to 9.5 million gate cubic yards at Veolia ES Valley View Landfill, Decatur. The application (Log number 2009-571) was still under review as of Dec. 31, 2011. If this landfill expansion does not receive approval, the site might close in 2013.

Temporarily closed landfills may still report capacity

One landfill did not accept any waste during 2011 because it was temporarily closed. Streator Area Landfill #3 became inactive in 2005; that was while the landfill's vertical expansion was under construction.

The operator of Streator Area Landfill #3 has also withdrawn the submittal of a permit application for a horizontal expansion for 4.7 million additional cubic yards air space. Final closure activities, such as final cover construction is under way at this time, with completion of the construction activities expected in 2012.

Transfer station in Charleston replaces closed landfill

ERC/Coles County Landfill, Charleston, closed on Apr. 30, 2009, and is still undergoing the closure process. A transfer station called Veolia ES SW Midwest LLC/Charleston opened at the landfill location near Charleston on May 1, 2009. An affidavit for certification for completion of closure was approved by Illinois EPA for this landfill owned by Environmental Reclamation Co., a subsidiary of Allied Waste/Republic Services on July 27, 2011. This landfill does not appear in this report, because it did not accept any waste in 2011 or report any capacity as of Jan. 1, 2012.

The counties of Adams, Brown, Calhoun, Cass, Christian, Greene, Jersey, Logan, Macoupin, Mason, Menard, Montgomery, Morgan, Pike, Sangamon, Schuyler and Scott are located in Region Five: West Central Illinois.

Landfills

Region Five's four active landfills accepted more than 1.6 million gate cubic yards of waste during 2011. This volume was 83,253 gate cubic yards more than 2010's total waste disposed of in landfills. This figure amounts to a 5.4 percent increase, which was the third highest of the four regions reporting more waste accepted in 2011. Statewide, waste disposed in landfills was up less than one (0.1) percent.

Waste disposed in landfills in West Central Illinois (Region Five) during 2011 amounted to only 3.5 percent of the state's total, the lowest in the state. Regional waste acceptance rates range from 3.5 in this region to 33.3 in Region One: Northwestern Illinois.

Out of state wastes accepted by one landfill

Litchfield-Hillsboro Landfill, Litchfield and Pike County Landfill, Baylis were the only facilities to accept waste from other states. Litchfield-Hillsboro Landfill accepted 22 percent of its waste from the state of Missouri. Seven percent of its waste receipts came from the states of Iowa and Missouri. This out-of-state waste totaling 81,762 amounted to 4.9 percent of the total waste received in the region.

Statewide, 6.1 million gate cubic yards were accepted from out-of-state. Data showed that in 2011, 13.3 percent of the municipal waste accepted came from eleven other states besides Illinois: Arkansas, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, South Dakota, Tennessee and Wisconsin.

Capacity down 3.8 percent in region

Region Five has the second fewest operating landfills located in any region, five. Only Region Six has fewer and it has four. These five landfills reported 3.8 percent less available capacity from the year before, down 1.5 million gate cubic yards. Capacity declined at amounts ranging from 1.5 million gate cubic yards in this Region to 10.6 million gate cubic yards in Region 4: East Central Illinois.

Capacity declined in four regions (East Central Illinois, West Central Illinois, Metropolitan East St. Louis and Southern Illinois) as of Jan. 1, 2012 at rates ranging from 1.7 percent in this region to 5.6 percent in Region Four: East Central Illinois

This region also has the lowest capacity share of all the regions: 3.7 percent. Regional capacity ranges from 3.7 in this region to 25.1 in Region Three: Peoria/Quad Cities.

Regional landfill life one more year remaining than statewide average: at 24 years

Region Four: East Central Illinois. Peoria/Quad Cities (Region Three) and Southern Illinois (Region Seven) tied for first at 54 years, and Region Four: East Central Illinois, which has 25 years all have more years of landfill life remaining than this Region. Coming in fourth is Region Five: West Central Illinois, which has 24 years of landfill life remaining. On the low end, Region Six: Metropolitan East St. Louis is in fifth place with 17 years remaining; Region One: Northwestern Illinois at sixth place with 16 years of landfill life remaining and Region Two: Chicago Metropolitan Area comes in seventh place with just 12 years remaining. The whole state has 23 years of landfill capacity left when dividing waste acceptance amounts by capacity remaining.

Jerseyville's landfill has been temporarily closed since 2006

One landfill was temporarily closed in 2009, 2010 and 2011: RCS Landfill Inc., Jerseyville. Intermediate cover including seed and straw was applied. A plan for temporary suspension of waste acceptance was approved by Illinois EPA during this time. This landfill will continue to report capacity to Illinois EPA each January 1st, until it re-opens or closes permanently.

Four landfills are open; RCS Landfill Inc. nearing closure

All four active facilities in the Region expect to remain open into 2012. However, RCS Landfill Inc. has reported to the Illinois EPA that during the construction seasons of 2010, 2011 and 2012 the site will be undergoing final cover construction and grading, in preparation for site closure during 2012.

Name change for Pike County Landfill in 2012 To Hickory Ridge Landfill Inc.

The name for Pike County Landfill has been changed to Hickory Ridge Landfill by its owner and operator. This happened as part of the host agreement negotiations finalized in October 2011, with the Pike County Board. The landfill's name change was recorded with Illinois Secretary of State Jesse White's office, Department of Business Services on March 30, 2012.

Region Six covers the following nine counties:

The counties of Bond, Clinton, Fayette, Madison, Marion, Monroe, Randolph, St. Clair, and Washington are located in Region Six: St. Louis Metropolitan East.

Landfills

During 2011, three St. Louis Metropolitan East facilities received 16.2 percent of solid wastes disposed in landfills statewide. This was the third highest amount disposed in landfills behind Region One: Northwestern Illinois which reported 33.3 percent waste share and Region Two: Chicago Metropolitan at 17.1 percent.

The amount disposed in 2011 decreased by 3.9 percent from the previous year. Almost 7.5 million gate cubic yards of wastes were disposed in landfills in the St. Louis Metropolitan East area in 2011. Figures differed by 283,563 gate cubic yards from year to year.

Three landfills rank in top 10 listing for waste receipts

Roxana Landfill Inc., Roxana, had the distinction of ranking fourth in the state in terms of quantities of municipal waste disposed in landfills during 2011. Milam Recycling and Disposal Facility (RDF), East St. Louis, ranked fifth and Cottonwood Hills RDF ranked eighth. These three landfills together accepted 16.2 percent of the waste that was disposed in landfills in the state.

More than 45.3 percent of wastes disposed in the region came from seven other states

Of the more than 7.5 million gate cubic yards of waste accepted, almost 3.4 million gate cubic yards originated outside Illinois.

Three Region Six landfills received 45.3 percent of their waste from these seven states: Arkansas, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Missouri and Tennessee.

Three landfills that accepted waste from other states and out-of-state percentages follow: Cottonwood Hills RDF, Marissa, (72 percent of receipts at the site were from Indiana and Missouri); Milam RDF (37 percent of receipts at the site were from Arkansas, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Missouri and Tennessee) and Roxana Landfill Inc. (40 percent of its waste receipts came from Missouri).

The total percent of out-of-state waste accepted from 11 other states in all Illinois landfills during 2011 was 13.3 percent, up 2.3 percent from the previous year.

Landfill capacity decreased by 3.1 percent year to year

On Jan. 1, 2012, four of Region Six's landfills reported that capacity had decreased by more than 4.0 million gate cubic yards, providing 3.1 percent less capacity this year. Landfill operators reported 17 years of landfill life in the region. This is next to the least amount of landfill life remaining in a region; only two regions have less. Region One: Northwestern Illinois has 16 years of landfill life remaining and Region Two: Chicago Metropolitan has 12 years of landfill life remaining. Statewide, there are 23 years of landfill life remaining.

The more than 87.9 million gate cubic yards of capacity reported by fourth-ranked Cottonwood Hills RDF on Jan. 1, 2012 is 69.5 percent of the landfill capacity available in the region, and is also 8.4 percent of the capacity available in the state.

Two landfills in the region closed in 2010; none closed in 2011

The operators of Bond County Landfill, Greenville, ceased accepting waste on March 31, 2010. The site still reported capacity remaining as of Jan. 1, 2012.

Salem Municipal Landfill also closed on Oct. 15, 2010. The operator, the City of Salem's Public Works Department reported zero capacity remaining at the beginning of 2011; and did not report for Jan. 1, 2012.

Still the Region reports 17 years of landfill life remaining at the three landfills in the Region.

The counties of Alexander, Clay, Edwards, Franklin, Gallatin, Hamilton, Hardin, Jackson, Jefferson, Johnson, Lawrence, Massac, Perry, Pope, Pulaski, Richland, Saline, Union, Wabash, Wayne, White and Williamson are located in Region Seven, Southern Illinois.

Landfills

Region Seven's five active landfills accepted just more than 1.8 million gate cubic yards of waste during 2011. This volume was down 13.7 percent, or 300,463 gate cubic yards less than 2010's total. This was the biggest decline in capacity of the three regions reporting declining capacity. One landfill in the Region was temporarily closed during 2009, 2010 and 2011. Another landfill, Wayne County Landfill Inc., Fairfield, although reporting waste accepted in 2011, chose to temporarily close on April 13, 2012 for business reasons.

Southern Illinois Regional Landfill Inc., De Soto, accounted for 61.2 percent of the waste disposed in landfills in the region during 2011, yet it was not in the State's top 10 listing.

Out- of-state waste came to four landfills from five states

Four of these five active landfills accepted waste from five other states: Arkansas, Indiana, Kentucky, Missouri and Tennessee.

An amount of 55,080 gate cubic yards (25 percent of its waste stream) came to Perry Ridge Landfill, DuQuoin, from Missouri. Of the 1,155,514 gate cubic yards of waste received by Southern Illinois Regional Landfill Inc. in 2011, 216,750 gate cubic yards, or 19 percent, came from the states of Arkansas, Indiana, Kentucky, Missouri and Tennessee.

Two other landfills also accepted wastes from other states. West End Disposal Facility, Thompsonville, accepted 9,783 gate cubic yards, or 5 percent of its waste, from Kentucky and Sumner Landfill Inc. accepted 1,098 gate cubic yards or 1 percent of its waste from Indiana.

Only Wayne County Landfill Inc., Fairfield, did not accept any out-of-state waste in 2011

The percentage of imported waste for the region is 14.9 percent, considerably less than Region Six (St. Louis Metropolitan East), where out-of-state waste comprised 45.3 percent of total waste disposed in landfills. The state-wide average of imported waste for 2011 is 13.3 percent.

Landfill capacity decline reported as 4.4 percent

As of Jan. 1, 2012, the region's landfills reported a total capacity of more than 101.1 million gate cubic yards, declining more than 1.7 million gate cubic yards less than the previous year. The capacity declined 1.7 percent.

Three other regions reported decreased capacity at the beginning of 2012: Region Four (East Central Illinois) reported capacity was down 5.6 percent; Region Five (West Central Illinois) reported a 3.8 percent decline; and Region Six (St. Louis Metropolitan East) also reported a 3.1 percent decline.

Ninth-ranked Southern Illinois Regional Landfill Inc. has more than 41.9 million cubic yards of capacity available. It is the only landfill in Region Seven to rank in the top 10 list for capacity remaining.

Two landfills sold in October 2010 to Allied Waste/Republic Services

In October 2010, Veolia ES Solid Waste Inc. sold the two facilities located near Fairfield and Sumner to Allied Waste/Republic Services. The changes in ownership must be registered with the Illinois EPA with transfer of ownership and operating rights within 90 days of purchase. The names of the facilities were changed to drop the former company name.

Saline County Landfill still temporarily closed, and will remain so

At Saline County Landfill, Harrisburg, part of Unit II had been initially developed, but is not ready for waste acceptance. The operator reported in 2010 that the site was to remain inactive until business conditions made the site economically viable. However, in July 2011, an affidavit for certification of closure was submitted to the Agency for its review, which is still pending as of Dec. 31, 2011.

All four landfills remained open into 2012, however one closed in April 2012

On April 13, 2012 Wayne County Landfill Inc., Fairfield, temporarily closed for business reasons. This business decision was reported to the local inspector and to the press. This landfill continues to be inspected by Wayne County Health Department (618-842-5166) and Illinois EPA's regional office in Marion (618-993-7200).

The other landfills in De Soto, Du Quoin, Sumner and Thompsonville remain open through 2012.

Landfill life remaining is 54 years

Life remaining at the Southern Illinois landfills is 54 years. Region Three, the Peoria/Quad Cities area is tied with this region for the number of remaining years. The range of landfill life is from 12 years in the Chicago Metropolitan area to 54 years in both of these regions, and the landfill life remaining for all of the state is 23 years.
