Public Notice Number BWC:11051201.bwc is hereby given by Illinois EPA, Division of Water Pollution Control, Permit Section, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, Post Office Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276 (herein Agency) that a draft modified National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit Number IL0049191 has been prepared under 40 CFR 124.6(d) for Ameren Energy Generating Company, 1901 Chouteau Avenue, (MC-602), P.O. Box 66149, St. Louis, Missouri 63166-6149 for discharge into Newton Lake from the Ameren Energy Generating Company, Newton Power Station, 6725 North 500th Street, Newton, Illinois 62448, (Jasper County).

The Agency will conduct a public hearing on the draft permit modifications on Tuesday, August 30, 2011 at 6:00 p.m. in the main courtroom on the 2nd floor of the Jasper County Courthouse, 100 West Jourdan Street, Newton, Illinois. The Agency will accept oral comments on the draft permit modifications at this hearing. Written comments will be accepted through September 29, 2011.

The applicant is engaged in the operation of Newton Power Station which is an existing 1210 MW coal fired steam-electric generating station consisting of two pulverized coal wet bottom boilers. (SIC 4911). A once through cooling system is used to cool the main condensers for each unit, and condenser cooling water is discharged to Newton Lake for dissipation of waste heat via a discharge flume. Lake water is used for ash sluicing, and station service water is used to supply the water treatment plant and various heat exchangers. Plant operation results in an average discharge of 17.2 MGD of secondary ash pond discharge from outfall 001, 0.00055 MGD of sewage treatment plant #2 effluent from outfall A01, and 0.0256 MGD of sewage treatment plant #1 effluent from outfall 003. Discharges from other outfalls contained in the Permit are unaffected by the proposed modifications.

Current Permit modifications include, the addition of limits for phosphorus have been placed on outfalls A01 and 003 due to the implementation of the Little Wabash River II TMDL, which was approved November 12, 2007 and included a waste load allocation for the Newton Power Station's Sewage Treatment Plants. In addition, the secondary ash pond discharge from outfall 001 is proposed to increase from 8.31 MGD to 17.2 MGD due to the addition of fly ash sluice water from generating unit 2, the increase of fly ash sluice water from generating unit 1, some minor increases to water treatment plant related wastewater, and some corrections to existing flows due to previous calculation errors. As a result of the plant modifications, a condition has been added to the permit requiring monitoring of various metals at outfall 001. Additionally, phosphorus monitoring has been added to outfall 001 and an influent monitoring requirement has been added for total suspended solids and phosphorus. The results of these additional monitoring requirements will be used to verify Ameren's claim that the net loading to Newton Lake for total phosphorus and total suspended solids will not be increased due to the additional fly ash sluice water.

The application, draft permit and other documents are available for inspection and may be copied at the Agency between 9:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday.
