Members of the Illinois EPA and Countryside Genco will be available to give an overview and answer questions about the request by Countryside Genco to install new turbines at its gas-to-energy facility at the Countryside Landfill. The public is invited to attend. The public meeting is being held to give the public an opportunity to learn about the project. Written public comments are being accepted until November 8, 2011

Countryside Genco has requested a construction permit to install four new turbines at its landfill gas to energy facility located at the Countryside Landfill, 31725 N. Route 83 in Grayslake. The four new turbines would replace the six smaller turbines currently in use at the facility.

The Illinois EPA is accepting written comments on the draft construction permit after the Public Meeting until November 8, 2011.
