

On September 20, 2011 the Illinois EPA discovered that the draft permit for Dynegy Midwest Generation Havana Power Station did not contain the correct signature block on the draft permit and did not include the standard conditions. Illinois EPA has made the following non-substantive changes to the public noticed permit:

1. Revised the signature block to Alan Keller, P.E., Manager, Permits Section, Division of Water Pollution Control;
2. Deleted a blank page contained at the end of the document; and,
3. Added the four pages of standard conditions (used in all NPDES permits issued by Illinois EPA) to the end of the document.

In addition to these changes, Illinois EPA is also arranging to have an aerial photograph of the facility posted on the web.
