The purpose of these meetings is to provide an opportunity for the public to receive information and comment on the draft Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) and Load Reduction Strategy (LRS) concerning impairments to the Middle Illinois River watershed. The potential TMDL causes of impairment to the river are fecal coliform bacteria, total dissolved solids and chloride. The causes of impairment to the backwater lakes are phosphorus and

dissolved oxygen. The LRS impairments are phosphorus, nitrate-nitrogen and total suspended solids.

This TMDL/LRS report includes data analysis and determination of the pollutant loading capacity and reductions necessary to meet designated uses and water quality standards.

The IEPA implements the TMDL program in accordance with Section 303(d) of the federal Clean Water Act. A TMDL is the sum of the allowable amounts of a single pollutant (phosphorus, metals, etc.) that a waterbody can receive from all contributing sources and still meet water quality standards or designated uses.

The draft Stage Three Report for the Middle Illinois River watershed will be available on-line at www.epa.state.il.us/public-notices.
