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- 1 MR. STUDER: Let's go ahead and go on the record.
- 2 Good afternoon. My name is Dean Studer, and
- 3 I'm the hearing officer for the Illinois Environmental
- 4 Protection Agency, or Illinois EPA.
- 5 My purpose today is to ensure that this
- 6 hearing runs in a fair and orderly manner and according
- 7 to rules. This hearing is being held for the purpose
- 8 of gathering public comment on the proposed amendments
- 9 to Illinois EPA's Alternate Fuels Program rules, 35
- 10 Illinois Administrative Code Part 275.
- 11 The Illinois Environmental Protection
- 12 Agency's proposal would amend Part 275 to reflect
- 13 amendments to Section 30 of the Alternate Fuels Act,
- 14 referred to as the Act in today's proceeding. This was
- 15 signed into law on July 11, 2011, as Public Act
- 16 97-0090. Amendments to Section 30 of the Act establish
- 17 an electric vehicle car sharing grant program. These
- 18 amendments provide that, through fiscal year 2013, the
- 19 Illinois EPA may award grants to car-sharing
- 20 organizations for the purchase of new electric vehicles
- 21 from an Illinois car dealership to the extent that
- 22 funds remain available from the alternate fuel vehicle
- 23 rebate fund. Also, amendments to Section 30 provide
- 24 grant award criteria, eligibility requirements,

- 1 application requirements, funding limitations, and
- 2 reporting requirements.
- 3 The Illinois EPA's proposed amendments to
- 4 Part 275 establish procedures for the issuance of
- 5 electric vehicle car-sharing grants. Specifically, the
- 6 proposed amendment establishes the availability and
- 7 limitations of grants, grant application requirements,
- 8 and the criteria and procedures relating to the
- 9 Illinois EPA's award of grants and grant funding
- 10 amounts.
- In addition, the proposed amendments
- 12 establish requirements relating to grant agreements,
- 13 access to grant projects, audits, maintenance of
- 14 records, reporting, and reimbursement. Also, the
- 15 proposed amendments establish procedures for addressing
- 16 noncompliance with grant requirements. The Illinois
- 17 EPA's proposed amendments also make clarifications
- 18 relating to the Alternate Fuel Vehicle Rebate Program.
- 19 Copies of this proposal are available on the Illinois

- 21 This is the second of two hearings that
- 22 Illinois EPA is holding regarding the proposed
- 23 amendments to 35 Illinois Administrative Code Part 275.
- 24 The first hearing was held yesterday, March 7, 2012, at

- 1 Illinois Environmental Protection Agency building at
- 2 1021 North Grand Avenue East.
- 3 This hearing is being held under the
- 4 provisions of 35 Illinois Administrative Code 164,
- 5 Procedures for Informational and Quasi-Legislative
- 6 Public Hearings. Copies of these procedures can be
- 7 accessed on the website for the Illinois Pollution
- 8 Control Board at www.ipcb.state.il.us, or, if you do
- 9 not have ready access to the web, these regulations can
- 10 be obtained from me on request.
- 11 Illinois EPA staff members present today will
- 12 introduce themselves and make presentations following
- 13 this overview. I will allow the public to ask
- 14 questions or provide comments. Written comments will
- 15 be accepted as long as they are postmarked by April 9,
- 16 2012. April 9, 2012, is the date that the hearing
- 17 record will officially close. With that let's go off
- 18 the record for a minute.
- 19 (Brief pause.)
- 20 MR. STUDER: We're going to go back on the record.
- 21 For the record, I do want to point out that
- 22 there are no members of the public here, nor have there
- 23 been at any time during this proceeding. This hearing
- 24 record will be open until April 9, 2012, and with that
