Public Notice of Landfill Expansion Development Permit Quad Cities Phase IV Landfill, Milan, Illinois

Millennium Waste, Inc.

Pursuant to the provisions of 415 ILCS 5/39(a), notice is hereby given that on June 13, 2012 the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) granted a development permit for lateral and vertical expansions at the Quad Cities Phase IV Landfill in Rock Island County, east of Milan, Illinois. The facility is owned and operated by Millennium Waste, Inc. and is identified as Illinois EPA/Bureau of Land Site No. 1610400018.

On September 23, 2008, the Illinois EPA received an application from Millennium Waste, Inc. for the development of a lateral and vertical expansion of the permitted municipal solid waste landfill unit. The landfill was originally permitted with one waste disposal unit (Permit No. 1992-131-LF). The newly permitted expansion will increase the overall facility boundaries from approximately 142 acres to 197 acres. The original unit had a waste disposal area of approximately 67 acres with a capacity of approximately 7,852,200 cubic yards (yd³); the approved expansion will increase the waste disposal footprint to 129 acres and increase the waste capacity to 25,600,000 yd³. The approved application and plans will allow this landfill expansion to be built. The expansion area may accept municipal solid waste and non-hazardous special waste for disposal only after the landfill unit is constructed and an Illinois EPA permit authorizing its operation has been issued.
