Extension of the

Public Comment Period in the Matter of the Renewal of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for the Ameren Energy Resources Generating Company E. D. Edwards Power Station in Bartonville through September 20, 2013 (Comments must be physically received by Illinois EPA by September 20, 2013)

On August 7, 2013 the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) conducted a public hearing for the renewal of the NPDES permit for the Ameren Energy Resources Generating Company E. D. Edwards Power Station. The post-hearing public comment period was to run through September 6, 2013. The Illinois EPA is extending the comment period in this matter through September 20, 2013. Comments must be postmarked or delivered to the carrier company so that they are physically received by the Illinois EPA no later than September 20, 2013. Illinois EPA strongly encourages the filing of e-mail comments in this matter. E-mail comments are to be sent to epa.publichearingcom@illinois.gov, must be received on or before September 20, 2013 and state either "Ameren ED Edwards NPDES" or "IL0001970" in the subject line.

Illinois EPA will consider all relevant comments that are actually received by the Illinois EPA by September 20, 2013 in making a final decision in this matter.
