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PUBLIC NOTICE OF HAZARDOUS WASTE MANAGEMENT PERMIT RENEWAL

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) hereby gives notice of intent to renew a Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) permit held by Chevron Environmental Management Company (CEMC) for their closed former Texaco refinery property at 301 West Second Street, Lockport, IL 60441. CEMC is performing corrective action and post-closure care at the site under its current RCRA permit. This permit renewal would make specific changes to the existing permit including an expansion of the CAMU. This renewal would remove certain property parcels where soil remediation has been completed from the definition of the permitted facility. Other existing requirements remain such as the requirement to address groundwater contamination under the entire property, including under those parcels where soil remediation has been completed.

Written comments on the draft renewal permit may be submitted during the 45-day comment period. Send comments to the Illinois EPA contact listed at the end of this Notice postmarked by midnight, **February 23, 2013**. In response to public requests or at the discretion of the Agency, a public hearing can be held to clarify technical issues concerning the draft permit. A public hearing request must be made in writing, express opposition to the draft permit and state the nature of the issue(s) to be raised at the hearing. Written hearing requests should be sent to the Illinois EPA contact listed below by the end of the comment period. Public notice will be issued 45 days before any hearing.

All comments received will become part of the Administrative Record (AR) and will be evaluated by the Agency in making the final permit decision. The Agency will respond to comments on the draft permit and indicate whether additional documents have been included in the AR. Commenters will be notified of the final permit decision and the permit decision appeal process.

The AR, including the permit application, draft permit, related information and all data submitted by the applicant, is now available for public inspection by appointment only Monday through Friday between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Please call the Illinois EPA contact below for an appointment to view the
