The IEPA Bureau of Water has prepared a draft National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for the Illinois Sand Company, LLC, 1601 Rockwell Rd., LaSalle, IL 61301.

Illinois EPA is holding this hearing for the purpose of taking comments on the draft permit prior to taking final action on the permit application. Issues relevant to this proceeding include the antidegradation analysis and the applicant's compliance with requirements of the federal Clean Water Act and Subtitle C and 35 Illinois Adm. Code. Because Illinois is mandated by state law to issue a permit if the applicant meets the requirements for obtaining a permit, those recommending denial of the permit application should be prepared to state the regulation that is the basis for their recommendation.

The applicant proposes a new surface sand mine and will be engaged in excavation, extraction and processing of industrial sand (SIC 1446). Wastewater is generated from pit pumpage, process water and stormwater runoff. Plant operations result in an average discharge of 0.144 MGD of groundwater seepage, process water and stormwater runoff from outfall 001 to an unnamed tributary of the Illinois River.
