The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) has made a tentative determination to terminate the NPDES permit for the above named discharger.

Discharge no(s): 001, 002, 003
Type of Waste: Lagoon Overflow (001), Feedlot Runoff (002) and Silage Pit Leachate (003)
Flow Rate: Intermittent during storm events
Classification: General Use
Receiving Waters: Tributary to Will Creek

The Agency intends to terminate the subject permit for the discharges. The permittee and current owners have failed to respond to notice of incomplete submission letters and have not provided all relevant facts regarding renewal of the NPDES permit or future operations at this site. The latest inspection of January 8, 2014 verified that livestock had been removed from this facility and the current owners indicate that there are no plans to raise livestock at this facility. The inspection of January 8, 2014 did not indicate any discharge from the facility. Therefore, the Agency intends to terminate the permit due to these causes in accordance with 40 CFR 122.64 (a)(2) and (4).

Interested persons are invited to submit written comments to the IEPA at the above address. The NPDES permit and notice number(s) must appear on each comment page. Any interested person may submit a written request for a public hearing, stating his or her name and address, the nature of the issues proposed to be raised and the evidence proposed to be presented with regards to those issues.

The application, Public Notice/Fact Sheet, comments received, and other documents are available for inspection and may be copied at the IEPA between 9:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday.

All comments on the intended termination of the permit and requests for hearing must be received by the IEPA not later than 30 days from the date of this publication. If written comments or requests indicate a significant degree of public interest, the permitting authority may, at its discretion, hold a public hearing. Public notice will be given 45 days before any public hearing. For further information call the Public Notice Clerk at 217/782-0610.
