Proposed Construction Permit
Mayco Industries, Inc. in Granite City

Mayco Industries, Inc. is required by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency to obtain a construction permit for a new cartridge filter, modification of process and fugitive emission limitations, and other modifications to control lead emissions from its facility at 1200 16th Street in Granite City. Issuance of the permit and implementation of the controls specified in the permit is necessary for the Illinois EPA plan to meet the new federal National Ambient Air Quality Standard for the amount of lead in the ambient air.
