The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) has made a tentative determination to terminate the NPDES permit for the above named discharger.

Discharge no(s): 001  
Type of Waste: Utility Tunnel Dewatering  
Flow Rate: 0.08 MGD  
Classification: Non-Recreational Use  
Receiving Waters: Chicago Sanitary and Ship Canal

The Agency intends to terminate the permit because the temporary dewatering activities have ceased and the discharge has been eliminated. The discharge was generated by the temporary dewatering of a utility tunnel to conduct inspection and maintenance activities which were completed in September 2013.

Interested persons are invited to submit written comments to the IEPA at the above address. The NPDES permit and notice number(s) must appear on each comment page. Any interested person may submit a written request for a public hearing, stating his or her name and address, the nature of the issues proposed to be raised and the evidence proposed to be presented with regards to those issues.

The application, Public Notice/Fact Sheet, comments received, and other documents are available for inspection and may be copied at the IEPA between 9:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday.

All comments on the intended termination of the permit and requests for hearing must be received by the IEPA not later than 30 days from the date of this publication. If written comments or requests indicate a significant degree of public interest, the permitting authority may, at its discretion, hold a public hearing.
