## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

In accordance with the requirements of the Groundwater Protection Act, notification is hereby provided to the owners of private, semi-private, and non-community water systems in or near Princeville of the discovery of the volatile organic compound tetrachloroethylene (PCE), trichloroethylene (TCE), and xylene and of the need to test their systems for potential contamination. PCE and TCE were detected at levels above the groundwater quality standards and xylene was also detected but at levels below the groundwater quality standard. Although the contaminants were found in the source water, the water provided by Princeville meets U.S. Environmental Protection Agency standards. According to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, the area potentially affected by contamination is located North of the railroad, .66 miles East of State Route 91, .56 miles West of State Route 91, and .5 miles North of Main Street (State Route 90).
