PUBLIC NOTICE

In accordance with the requirements of the Groundwater Protection Act, notification is hereby provided to the owners of private, semi-private, and non-community water systems in or near Roanoke of the discovery of the volatile organic compound Benzene and of the need to test their systems for potential contamination. According to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, the area potentially affected by contamination is located East of County Highway 1700E, South of County Highway 1500N, North of Panther Creek, and West of ½ mile East of North Main Street. For a listing of laboratories certified to analyze drinking water for volatile organic compounds, interpretation of any test results, contaminant health effects information, and recommendations for individuals who regularly consume well water, contact Eric Lane, Woodford County Health Department, 109 S.
