The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) gives notice of its intent to approve a renewed Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Hazardous Waste Management Permit (draft permit) for Dyno Nobel, Inc., an explosive products manufacturing plant located at 5570 State Route 3 North in Wolf Lake. The permit would require Dyno Nobel, Inc. to complete closure of two former miscellaneous open-burning units, continue corrective action at three solid waste management units (SWMUs) to address past releases, and continue post-closure care, including groundwater monitoring, for two former non-hazardous surface impoundments that were closed as landfills.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD AND PUBLIC HEARING

On July 9, 2026, the Illinois EPA issued a public notice with a 45-day written public comment period that ended August 24, 2026.

As requested during the initial public comment period, the Illinois EPA is holding an additional public comment period and public hearing to offer an opportunity to the public to provide written and/or oral comments on this proposed action prior to making a final decision. After consideration of any comments received, the Illinois EPA will make a final decision on this proposed action. All public comments received during the public comment period will become part of the Administrative Record (AR) and will be evaluated by the Illinois EPA in making the final decision on the draft permit. The Illinois Pollution Control Board rules that govern the issuance of the permit are found at 35 Ill. Adm. Code 705. The Illinois EPA will respond to public comments and indicate whether additional documents have been included in the AR. Commenters will be notified of the final permit decision and the permit decision appeal process.

Written Public Comment Period

The Illinois EPA invites written public comments on the draft permit during the comment period. All written public comments must be received no later than **11:59 PM on Thursday, December 10, 2026**.
