## Notice of Public Hearing and Comment Period Bureau of Air Construction Permit Bureau of Land Development Permit Green Era Renewable Energy & Urban Farming Campus

Green Era Renewable Energy & Urban Farming Campus (Green Era) has applied to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) Bureau of Air (BOA) and Bureau of Land (BOL) for permits to develop a Liquid and Solid Food Waste Recycling Facility at 650 West 83<sup>rd</sup> Street in Chicago, Illinois. The facility will process 80,000-tons/year food waste to produce compost and biomethane; the biomethane will be injected into the local natural gas utility system. Both solid and liquid food waste will be processed from the greater Chicago metro area and surrounding Cook County.

Green Era has applied for a construction permit from BOA. The construction permit establishes the emissions regulations, compliance and monitoring of air pollutants from the facility. The project is not considered major for purposes of the state's rules for Major Stationary Sources Construction and Modification (MSSCAM), 35 Ill. Adm. Code Part 203. The source is not a major source under Illinois' rules for the Prevention of Significant Deterioration, 35 Ill. Adm. Code Part 204.

Green Era has also applied for a BOL permit to develop a food waste composting facility. The facility operations will include receiving the food waste inside a processing building and anaerobic digestion of food wastes in an aboveground tank. The facility will be regulated under the requirements established in 35 III. Adm. Code Part 807. Upon completion of development, the facility will be required to obtain an operating permit. Food waste can only be accepted after approval of the operating permit application by the Illinois EPA BOL.

The Illinois EPA has reviewed the applications and made preliminary determinations that both applications meet standards for issuance and has prepared draft BOA and BOL permits for public review and comment.

The Illinois EPA is holding a public hearing on Thursday, November 17, 2022 at 7:00 pm at the Auburn Gresham Healthy Lifestyle Hub located at 839 West 79<sup>th</sup> Street in Chicago to receive public comments regarding the draft permits and permit applications. The hearing will be held pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code Part 166, Subpart A (Procedures for Permit and Closure Plan Hearings). The Illinois EPA will present opening statements concerning the draft permits and hearing procedures prior to accepting comments from the public during the hearing.
