Re: Consent Order in *People v. Sterigenics U.S., LLC*, No. 2018 CH 001329 – Submission of Stack Test Protocol and Air Monitoring Plan

Dear Mr. Mattison and Mr. Mohr:

Pursuant to paragraph III.D of the above-captioned consent order, Sterigenics submits, for Illinois EPA's review and approval, a Stack Test Protocol and Air Monitoring Plan.

Sterigenics recently has announced that it intends to close the Willowbrook I facility permanently. Because the stack testing and air monitoring programs described in the enclosed plans are to take place only once the Willowbrook I facility resumes operations, Sterigenics' announcement means that these programs will not be implemented. We have reached out to Illinois EPA and the Attorney General's office regarding the process to terminate the consent order; however, because the order is not yet terminated, Sterigenics submits the draft plans as contemplated in the order.
