    - Discussed climate funding distribution to communities
  - 2. Air, Water, and Soil Quality Monitoring & Enforcement (Subcommittee Chair, Ashish Sharma):
    - Discussed priorities including safe drinking water, sewage outflows, and pollution-permitting reform
    - Concerned over large data centers entering EJ communities (impact on energy and stability)
    - Discussed the potential for planning statewide EJ screening guidance and coordination with Illinois EPA
  - 3. Funding Equity & Workforce Development (Chynna Hampton reporting):
    - Focused on partnering with Illinois DCEO to make funding more accessible
    - Discussed need for increasing member participation to shape future actions

- When/how to engage with legislation
- Commission has advisory role (i.e. reviewing legislation, not drafting or testifying)
- Commission gives input via annual reports, not public testimony
- Commission acts as a clearinghouse for EJ-related legislation
- Members may speak individually but not on behalf of the Commission.
- Illinois EPA's legislative team to brief on EJ-related bills during next quarterly meeting
- Potential off-meeting training on how to navigate Illinois legislative systems
- Draft 2025 Annual Report Review
  - Draft available on Microsoft Teams and by email
  - Final Report Review Meeting: September 24 (1–3pm virtual, via Webex)
  - Report due October 1 to Governor and General Assembly
  - Subcommittees should integrate their focus and key takeaways
