In accordance with the Illinois EPA's Environmental Justice Policy, the Office of Environmental Justice wants to provide you with information about a potential action. The Illinois EPA is sending this letter to notify you of an application received by the Bureau of Air (BOA).

The Illinois EPA has received an application for renewal of the Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit for Allied Asphalt Paving Co located at 1555 West Washington Street in West Chicago. This is a drum mix asphalt plant that operates a drum mixer equipped with baghouse and uses water sprays on emission units.

The application is currently under review by the BOA. FESOP require public notice. Once ready for review, the Illinois EPA will post a public notice and draft permit on its website (<https://epa.illinois.gov/public-notices/boa-notices.html>) and will accept comments during the public notice period. The procedures for public participation in the Air Pollution Control Permit Program can be found at 35 Ill. Adm. Code Part 252.
