In accordance with the Illinois EPA's Environmental Justice Policy, the Office of Environmental Justice wants to provide you with information about a potential action. The Illinois EPA is sending this letter to notify you of an application received by the Bureau of Air (BOA).

The Illinois EPA has received an application for a Construction Permit from Meyer Steel Drum Inc located at 3201 South Millard Avenue in Chicago. The application requests authorization to make various changes at its plant to improve operational efficiency and reduce emissions of volatile organic materials and hazardous air pollutants. At its drum furnace, Meyer Steel Drum is proposing replacement of the gas-fired burners. At its three drum coating lines, Meyer Steel Drum is proposing improvements to increase the capture and control efficiency of emissions from the use of coating materials. At the drum washing operations, Meyer Steel Drum is proposing installation of equipment to capture emissions and duct these emissions to an existing thermal oxidizer.

The application is currently under review by the BOA.
