In accordance with the Illinois EPA's Environmental Justice Policy, the Office of Environmental Justice wants to provide you with information about potential actions. The Illinois EPA is sending this letter to notify you of applications received by the Bureau of Air (BOA).

The Illinois EPA has received applications for a Construction Permit and a renewed and revised Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit for Rockford Silk Screen located at 6201 Material Avenue in Loves Park. The Construction Permit application is for one roll coater, a device for printing patterns on fabrics which uses and emits volatile organic materials. The source has also applied for a renewal and revision to Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit, which will incorporate construction permit 24060025.

The applications are currently under review by the BOA. FESOP renewals require public notice. Once ready for review, the Illinois EPA will post a public notice and draft permit on its website (<a href="https://epa.illinois.gov/public-notices/boa-notices.html">https://epa.illinois.gov/public-notices/boa-notices.html</a>) and will accept comments during the public notice period. The procedures for public participation in the Air Pollution Control Permit Program can be found at 35 Ill. Adm. Code Part 252.
