This information shall be provided using either this form or in an alternative manner at your discretion. Failure to disclose the information may result in an incomplete application and other penalties as provided for in the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42-45. Intentional falsification of the information in this form may result in significant criminal and civil penalties as provided by law.
