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- iv. If 20,001 – 30,000 kg of used batteries stored on-site at any one time, then the cost estimate will be \$25,000.00.
- v. For facilities in which > 30,000 kg of used batteries are stored on-site at any one time, the cost estimate will be an additional \$2,500.00 for every additional 5,000 kg.
