RE: 2027 Illinois EPA Electronic Waste Program Plan Review

Dear Mr. Linnell,

This letter is to inform you that the Illinois EPA has received the manufacturer e-waste program plan, dated August 14, 2026, for program year 2026 ("the program plan") submitted on behalf of the National Center for Electronics Recycling ("NCER") Clearinghouse in accordance with the Illinois Consumer Electronics Recycling Act ("CERA"). Section 1-25 of CERA establishes the required elements of the program plan and states, in relevant part, that the plan shall include, at a minimum:

- The contact information for the individual who will serve as the point of contact for the manufacturer e-waste program ("the program");
- The identity of each county that has elected to participate in the program during the program year;
- For each county, the location of each program collection site and one-day collection event included in the program for the program year;
- The collector operating each program collection site and one-day collection event included in the program for the program year;
- The recyclers the manufacturers plan to use during the program year;
- An explanation of any deviation by the program from the standard program collection site distribution set forth in Section 1-15(a) of CERA;
- A certification that the methodology used for allocation responsibility for the transportation and recycling of residential consumer electronic devices by manufacturers participating in the clearinghouse program year will be in compliance with Section 1-84.5 of CERA;
- Identification of collection service provided to every county of the state, including program collection sites, program collection events, retail collection sites, and private network collection sites.

The Illinois EPA reviewed the program plan and determined that it does contain the required elements and satisfies the convenience standard set forth in Section 1-15 of CERA. The program plan is **approved based on the required information provided.**

The submitted program plan also provided additional information, including a document identified as NCER Illinois Manufacturer Clearinghouse Program Rules. Information not regulatorily required for approval were not within the scope of the Illinois EPA's review, and accordingly, were not considered part of the submission for the purposes of approving the program plan.

2. Identity of Opt-In Counties

Illinois EPA distributed a form in early 2026 to eligible Illinois counties and municipalities to opt-in to the manufacturer program under CERA for 2027. As a result of this process, 53 units of government elected to participate in the program. Below is a listing of the counties and other units of government who filed opt-in forms. The NCER Manufacturer Clearinghouse continued operation of the plan for 2027, using the Rules (Exhibit A) for how manufacturers would divide the responsibility for providing programs to those opt-in counties. Manufacturers had the option to participate outside of a “group plan” if their obligation percentage was over 3%. All manufacturers decided to fulfill their recycling responsibilities through one of five group plans, with the exception of one retailer-manufacturer. NCER assigned registered group plans to each county/municipality as noted below. Plans submitted collection sites or events to cover the minimum required under CERA or made other arrangements with the County/municipality. The attached Exhibit B notes which sites/events were selected that either meets/exceeds the minimum number required or notes deviations with County agreements.

3. Locations of Each Site/Event in Each Opt-In County

NCER has assigned each of the above counties and municipalities to one of five registered group plans working directly with a recycler or recyclers, or who are recyclers themselves. NCER attempted to honor existing relationships and preferences in the assignments – including those noted on the County opt-in forms - while balancing each collective group’s obligation percentage described in Section 6 below. In most cases, the group plan assigned for 2027 is the same as 2026. However, due to changes in the individual manufacturer obligation percentages and manufacturer selection changes from 2026, this was not possible in all cases. The list of each collection site/event for each opt-in county is included in the attached Exhibit B. For several counties, the actual date and location of collection event/s has yet to be determined, but the city and number of events agreed to by its assigned group plan/manufacturer is noted wherever possible.

4. Recyclers to Be Used

The list of recyclers to be used by all manufacturers and group plans in the Clearinghouse is included in Exhibit B along with the collection locations. In some cases, multiple recyclers are noted. In all cases, group plans and manufacturers under the Clearinghouse understand that recyclers must be registered and meet the requirements under CERA.

5. Deviation from the Standard Program Collection Site Distribution

Several counties proposed deviations from the collection site distribution requirements in their proposed list of sites/events. Many of these involve substituting collection events for permanent sites. Deviations are noted in the final column and the Clearinghouse has provided email confirmations from the counties documenting these deviations.

6. Allocation Methodology Certification

NCER has used the allocation methodology Sec. 1-84.5 to develop the adjusted total proportional responsibility for each manufacturer registered in 2027. To do so, NCER used collection data from all reports from 2019-2025 as well as initial data from the first quarter 2026 as reported by the group plans. The final return share by category used in proportional responsibility calculations is shown below. Due to a change in the CERA law, the new covered category of Home Audio devices has been added for 2027. In order to set an estimated return share of home audio devices in the recycling stream, NCER surveyed several recyclers to received actual or approximate data on the percentage that will be returned.

After setting the return share by category, NCER compiled data from IEPA-provided manufacturer registration forms to set market share percentages by weight for each category. The adjusted total proportional responsibility was the product of the manufacturer's product category sales weight percentage and the corresponding 2027 return share percentage.

Example:

Manufacturer A – 5% sales by weight in TVs, 10% sales in Monitors

5% TVs * 45% = 2.25%

10% Monitors * 6.5% = 0.65%

Manufacturer A Responsibility: 2.25% + 0.65% = **2.9%**

After setting the manufacturer responsibility percentages, NCER requested that group plans provide preferences on existing county/municipal sites as well as data on retail and other private collection efforts. Using data from the Opt-In Forms and 2019-2026 data, NCER developed a county by county (or municipality) estimate of pounds to be collected in 2027 and matched the group plans to the counties by relative estimated volume. As described in the attached Rules document [Exhibit A], manufacturers and their groups are able to offset the number of counties/municipalities assigned by reporting retailer, curbside and other qualified private collection efforts. As in previous years, this calculation also included reductions and additions to pounds estimated based on the true-up process described in Exhibit A. No sites used for meeting county minimums are included in the private programs.

Thank you for submitting a 2026 Opt-In Form for the Illinois electronics recycling program under the Consumer Electronics Recycling Act (CERA). The National Center for Electronics Recycling (NCER) is submitting an e-waste program through a manufacturer clearinghouse on behalf of all Illinois registered manufacturers for 2026. NCER administers the Illinois Manufacturer Clearinghouse directly now as ERRO, who previously contracted with NCER for this service, is in the process of winding down.

The Clearinghouse divides the responsibility for meeting the minimum collection requirements for Opt-In Counties among all registered manufacturers. The allocation of counties is based on the relative size of the manufacturers according to their market share and the relative share of their product types in the recycling stream. As in past years, all manufacturers have chosen to be assigned Opt-In Counties in groups administered by a Group Plan. For 2026, five Group Plans registered with the Clearinghouse on behalf of varying numbers of manufacturers. Group Plans are companies, such as recyclers or management companies, who have agreements with manufacturers to select and work with transporters and recyclers to carry out manufacturer obligations under CERA. In some cases the Group Plan is the same as the recycler, and in other cases the transporter and recycler are separate from the Group Plan administrator.

We are contacting you today to let you know which Group Plan your County/local government unit has been assigned for 2026. Below is the name of the Group Plan administrator and primary contact who will be in touch with you. The Group Plan contact will review the information

provided on your Opt-In form and work on details of the collection sites and/or events that will be offered in 2026. **The Group Plan assigned to your County in 2026 is:**

We will need your assistance to work on those details with the Group Plan if possible **before July 29th**. The Group Plans have been asked to report their assigned Counties' details by that date so the Clearinghouse can submit the plan to Illinois EPA by August 1st due to a one-month delay approved by Illinois EPA. Sites and events can be altered in the future if your circumstances change.

Here are a few details to keep in mind when discussing 2026 collection sites/events:

- If your local government unit and the Group Plan agree to utilize collection events, or if the number of collection sites proposed is fewer than the number required under CERA, the Group Plan will need something in writing from you (email suffices) stating that this is acceptable. This even applies if your opt-in form requested only events or fewer than the minimum number of sites.
- All of the details on collection events, such as the exact location and date, do not need to be finalized at this point. However, the Group Plan contact will need to submit the number of events in the county as well as the city or cities in which they will take place in 2026.
- In some cases the Group Plan assigned to your County/local government unit will change from 2025 to 2026. The Clearinghouse attempted to minimize these changes and follow preferences submitted on Opt-In forms and from the Group Plans. However, some changes were needed to balance differences in manufacturer obligations from this year to next and changes in manufacturer group plan selections. If there is a change, please work with the Group Plans on a transition plan after finalizing the 2026 collection sites/events details.

The Clearinghouse appreciates your participation in this program and looks forward to working with you to continue the successful electronics recycling programs in Illinois in 2026. Please contact us or your assigned Group Plan should you have any questions.

Hi Cynthia,

SWANCC does not require a deviation. As a municipal joint action agency, we are not subject to providing the full 15 sites – that is for all of Cook County (excluding Chicago, assuming Chicago opts in). We are only responsible for our pro rata share of the 15; based on a Cook County population of about 2.5 million and our Member population of about 800,000, we should account for 5 of the 15 sites and have the option to include more. We in fact have 7 by the statute: we operate 4 sites, plus there is a provision to substitute any permanent site with 4 one-day events which adds the equivalent of 3 more. (See attached, refer to highlighted portions on pages 7 and 8).

Dear Illinois Local Government Representative:

Thank you for submitting a 2026 Opt-In Form for the Illinois electronics recycling program under the Consumer Electronics Recycling Act (CERA). The National Center for Electronics Recycling (NCER) is submitting an e-waste program through a manufacturer clearinghouse on behalf of all Illinois registered manufacturers for 2026. NCER administers the Illinois Manufacturer Clearinghouse

directly now as ERRO, who previously contracted with NCER for this service, is in the process of winding down.

The Clearinghouse divides the responsibility for meeting the minimum collection requirements for Opt-In Counties among all registered manufacturers. The allocation of counties is based on the relative size of the manufacturers according to their market share and the relative share of their product types in the recycling stream. As in past years, all manufacturers have chosen to be assigned Opt-In Counties in groups administered by a Group Plan. For 2026, five Group Plans registered with the Clearinghouse on behalf of varying numbers of manufacturers. Group Plans are companies, such as recyclers or management companies, who have agreements with manufacturers to select and work with transporters and recyclers to carry out manufacturer obligations under CERA. In some cases the Group Plan is the same as the recycler, and in other cases the transporter and recycler are separate from the Group Plan administrator.

We are contacting you today to let you know which Group Plan your County/local government unit has been assigned for 2026. Below is the name of the Group Plan administrator and primary contact who will be in touch with you. The Group Plan contact will review the information provided on your Opt-In form and work on details of the collection sites and/or events that will be offered in 2026. **The Group Plan assigned to your County in 2026 is:**

We will need your assistance to work on those details with the Group Plan if possible **before July 29th**. The Group Plans have been asked to report their assigned Counties' details by that date so the Clearinghouse can submit the plan to Illinois EPA by August 1st due to a one-month delay approved by Illinois EPA. Sites and events can be altered in the future if your circumstances change.

Here are a few details to keep in mind when discussing 2026 collection sites/events:

- If your local government unit and the Group Plan agree to utilize collection events, or if the number of collection sites proposed is fewer than the number required under CERA, the Group Plan will need something in writing from you (email suffices) stating that this is acceptable. This even applies if your opt-in form requested only events or fewer than the minimum number of sites.
- All of the details on collection events, such as the exact location and date, do not need to be finalized at this point. However, the Group Plan contact will need to submit the number of events in the county as well as the city or cities in which they will take place in 2026.
- In some cases the Group Plan assigned to your County/local government unit will change from 2025 to 2026. The Clearinghouse attempted to minimize these changes

and follow preferences submitted on Opt-In forms and from the Group Plans. However, some changes were needed to balance differences in manufacturer obligations from this year to next and changes in manufacturer group plan selections. If there is a change, please work with the Group Plans on a transition plan after finalizing the 2026 collection sites/events details.

The Clearinghouse appreciates your participation in this program and looks forward to working with you to continue the successful electronics recycling programs in Illinois in 2026. Please contact us or your assigned Group Plan should you have any questions.
