Uncontaminated Soil Fill Operation Registration Form By Owner and/or Operator

In accordance with 35 Ill. Adm. Code 1100.515, owners and operators of Uncontaminated Soil Fill Operations (USFO's) must register their fill operation with the Illinois EPA utilizing this form. Owner and operators of USFO's that were registered with the Illinois EPA before August 27, 2012, pursuant to Section 22.51a(c) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act [415 ILCS 5/22.51a (c)], must re-register by October 26, 2012. Owners and operators of USFO's that were not registered with the Illinois EPA before August 27, 2012 must register prior to the receipt of any uncontaminated soil.

This form is to be submitted for facilities accepting EXCLUSIVELY uncontaminated soil as defined by Section 3.160(c) of the Act [415 ILCS 5/3.160(c)] and rules adopted thereunder for use as fill material in a former mine, quarry, or other excavation. This form is NOT for Clean Construction or Demolition Debris (CCDD) fill operations, which must have a permit prior to acceptance of CCDD or uncontaminated soil for use as fill in accordance with Section 22.51 of the Act [415 ILCS 5/22.51].

ALL information on this Registration Form is required with the exception of email addresses. You may complete this application online and save a copy to your computer, or you may manually fill out a printed copy. Completed forms should be signed and mailed to:
