Who is NREC?

Created in 2012 through state statute

Funded by \$.75/ton assessment on fertilizer sold in Illinois

Collaboration between ag, environmental groups, and state agencies

- Ensure adoption and implementation of practices that
 - o Optimize nutrient use efficiency
 - o Ensure soil fertility
 - Address Environmental concerns regarding fertilizer



Progress to date

Research Investments

- Over \$39M invested in research since 2013
- Projects at University of Illinois, Illinois State University, Southern Illinois University, Western Illinois University, Purdue

Outreach

- Multiple NREC publications focused on Cover Crops, MRTN, and turf applications
- Nearly 100 scholarly articles published in peer reviewed publications
- Annual Investment Insights Live event and field days
- New OEPP opportunities in 2024

Student Engagement

 Dozens of undergrad, Masters and PhD students supported each year with NREC funding

Research Highlights

- Streambank Phosphorus loss research
- Cover crops mixes and technologies
- Wheat as a double crop option to show nutrient loss reduction
- The role of legacy Phosphorus
- WASCOBs research
- Novel research that may be basic research now but could lead to new practices
 - lateral seepage
 - other exciting innovations
