Urban Stormwater Working Group Charge:

1. Explore funding, identify legislative initiatives and develop plans.
2. Coordinate outreach.
3. Orchestrate statewide efforts related to green infrastructure expansion and retrofitting, MS4 program training, and urban stream, lake and stormwater monitoring.

Tracking Subgroup Charge:

1. Determine what BMP implementation parameters (e.g. rain gardens, etc.) will be tracked and how it will be aggregated (e.g. per watershed, statewide, or category).
2. Determine data sources and who will accomplish the tracking.
3. Decide what calculation tool should be used and what is required to achieve NLRS goal reductions.

Legislative Subgroup Charge: Provide education about stormwater issues to governmental decision makers such as elected officials and stormwater managers.
