Extension of the Public Comment Period In the Matter of the Proposed Plan for Operable Unit 4, New Jersey Zinc/Mobil Chemical Superfund Site in DePue, Illinois through August 15, 2016

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) received a request to extend the public comment period in this matter for 30 days. Pursuant to the National Oil and Hazardous Substances Pollution Contingency Plan, 40 CFR §300.430(f)(3)(i)(C), Illinois EPA, as the lead agency, is extending the comment period for 30 additional days. Since extension of the comment period for 30 additional days would have the comment period end on a non-business day, the comment period in this matter has been extended through Monday, August 15, 2016.
